1. Access to Performances

• Complimentary or Discounted Tickets: Enable participants to attend performances.

2. Artistic Development Opportunities

- Rehearsal Access: Invite Lab participants to sit in on rehearsals
- Mentorship: Provide music staff, repetiteurs, conductors, or directors for mentorship.

3. Marketing and Visibility

- Share program updates via newsletters, social media, and websites.
- Joint Branding Opportunities: Acknowledge your organisation's role as an in-kind supporter.

4. Space and Infrastructure

 Venue Access: Offer office or studio spaces for mentorship meetings, script development sessions, or workshops.

5. Archival and Resource Access

• Library / Score Collections: Provide access to scores, recordings, or archival materials.
